Everyone,

Thanks to everyone who participated in last week's brainstorming session for the Liberty Road/ Woody Mill Road Vicinity Small Area Plan. I think we got some great ideas, and we have a great start and plenty of topics for discussion and refinement.

We have synthesized all of the comments we received, and organized them into topic areas. Attached, you will find a list of all the ideas that were discussed at last week's meeting, as well as some instructions on how to prioritize them. In short, first we're asking each of you to select the THREE most important themes that, in your opinion, would help promote your vision of a successful mixed use area. Secondly, we're asking you to select specific issues from each theme that could contribute to your vision becoming reality or that might hinder that vision. Further instructions are in the attached documents. You will need both documents to complete the exercises: one contains the exercises while the other provides the themes and issues. Both documents are word documents and the exercise can be completed by checking the appropriate boxes or choosing the appropriate drop down selection (just be sure to save your document after completing it!)

If you could look over the attached and complete the exercises sometime in the next week, it will help us greatly in beginning to draft a vision statement for the committee's review. If you can email your responses by next Friday (April 30) that would be appreciated. If you would like to print them out and do them by hand that is fine also. You can fax them or mail them to us. We'll also accept completed exercises at the next meeting although this effort is most successful if we can get your responses in advance of that meeting.
